Access: (machine translated)

From Reutte in the Lechtal we drive to the Plansee and there to the hamlet "Am Plansee" (9,8 km from Fernpassstraße B 179, exit Reutte Süd). From here we follow the road for another 2.5 km in a northerly direction - along the Torsäulenbach stream - towards Linderhof Castle. Here the bridge crosses the Teufelstalbach (signs on the bridge railing). 25 m further on, we can drive into a path on the right and park our car here.\n\nAccess is also possible from the direction of Oberammergau/Ettal. To do this, we leave the B23, which connects both towns, in a westerly direction onto the St2060 in the direction of Linderhof Castle. We pass Linderhof, cross the German-Austrian border and 2.1 km after passing the BMW conference center (formerly Hotel Ammerwald) we come to the bridge over the stream from the Teufelstal.

Approach: (machine translated)

We follow the path that begins somewhat hidden in the park area, but is clearly marked with a sign in the direction of Geierköpfe, Zwerchenbergalpe. The path first goes up in steep grassy slopes, then flattens and takes direction to the Zwerchenbergalpe. Before reaching the alp descend over the grassy slopes in a southerly direction to the stream, entering at the latest where the path crosses the stream. We must be careful not to descend too early and thus into the wrong ditch.

Tour: (machine translated)

We first follow the meandering stream until we reach the first rappel point. Now 33 rappels follow. At the beginning, the stream is somewhat cut, later it pours down broadly over the crags until it collects again in a chute in the last quarter.

Return: (machine translated)

After the last rappel (just after the rock fall, under which the water flows) we look for the most pleasant way to the road bridge at the edge of the stream.
