Access: (machine translated) From Pamplona on NA-700 towards Lizarra/Estella Just in the p.k. 29 we have the detour to the right to the NA-7020 to Vidaurre. In 4 kms we will arrive at Guembe, along San Antonio street there is a track that heads north, we will take it and park about 2kms away, next to the second fence, where the two races meet.		
Approach: (machine translated) Access bcos Burón and Euntzelaia From the parking of Guembe we will follow the track to the north, the same as the access of Burón, in a 90 degree turn to the north there is a path towards the stream that leaves us in the lower part (return of the upper part). We will continue along the track until it ends, here a small path that goes into the forest to go down to the stream, access to the upper part.		
Tour: (machine translated) Both descents are very well-dressed and without large verticals, to be done after heavy rains so that the pools are clean. The two parts are separated by an open area, of skills and the access path to the lower part. In the lower part we will find a couple of longer and more interesting rappels, especially the one with the natural arch.		
Return: (machine translated) We will leave on the right by a path towards the access track in the case of leaving after the upper part. At the bottom we will stop at some fields that if we cross them to the right leaves us on the access track.


