We continue and at the next sharp turn to the right we park. Fouillet river.

To the right is the access road, both to link sectors and to leave and return to the car.

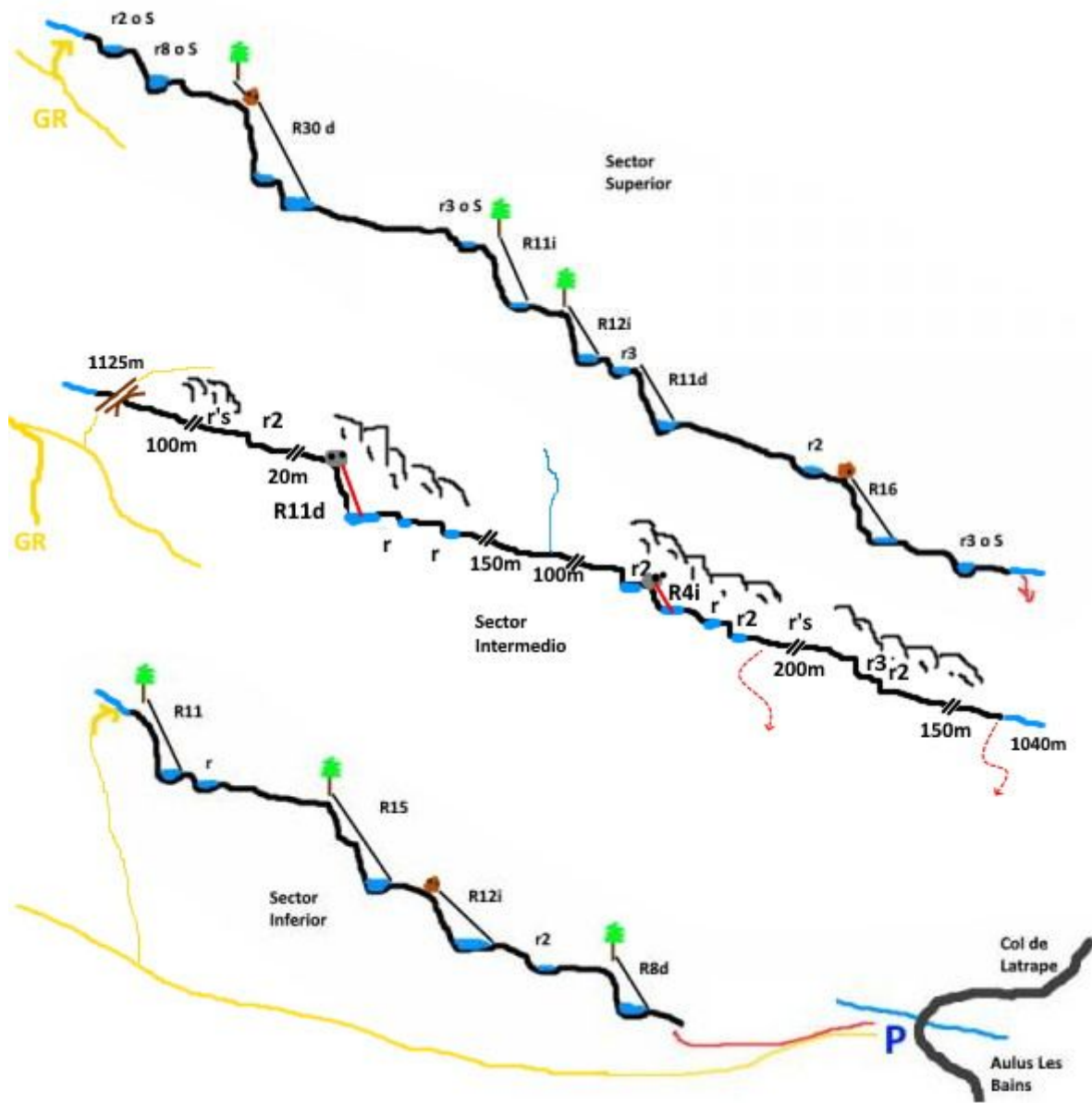
