Short and, in general, dry descent perfect to combine with Cal Catriques. Actually it is only two rappels, one of them of 33m in a spectacular cirque, although the original review begins above with a somewhat dressed area of skills and continues doing one more rappel to exit by the lower path, we consider more successful to save those parter and do Catriques and the interesting part of Esquitlla.

Access: (machine translated)

From Berga towards Sant Llorenç de Morunys on the BV-4241/LV-4241 at km. 11.6 the detour to the left to Capolat.

We will pass by different farmhouses until we reach Taravil, we leave it to one side and soon we will find a detour to the right to Vilella. We continue on the left and park after 20-30m on the left in a secluded area. We will see the GR exit on the right.

Approach: (machine translated)

Accesses Ca l'Esquitlla and Cal Catriques

We leave by the GR and in 15-20 min we find a sharp right turn on our stream.

Tour: (machine translated)

A few first descents to lead to the first rappel in some boxwoods on the orographic left, another pair of descents and we arrive at the strong point of the descent, a 30m rappel from a pine tree on the left of the riverbed.

Once descended we will be able to continue until we find a path, although this part of the descent no longer has much interest.

Return: (machine translated)

After the 33m rappel we have the GR curve on our left, a little uncomfortable access through the forest but if we continue a few meters along the riverbed, soon we can get out to it more easily.

We go up the GR to the car


