Summary: (machine translated) Also known as Atajo because of its toponymy although in the area it is better known as Marrubio because of the rock that gives it its name. Parallel to the Torre ravine with which it shares access and return, very vertical in its most interesting part and with a lot of walking between rocks. Access: (machine translated) Location of Ajoque, Marrubio, Torre and Baranda bcos. On the road to Buenavista del Norte, with the return car we will continue towards the lighthouse / Punta de Teno on the TF445. At the p.k. 2,5 there is a deposit to the left of the road and a place to park, it is the control point of the access to the lighthouse. From here there is a PR-TF58 to the Risco. Here we will leave the return vehicle or the access car if we make the ascent on foot. With the access vehicle we return to Buenavista, we leave by the road to El Palmar TF436, just past El Palmar we take the detour to the right to Teno Alto. We will go to Teno where we will turn right on the track La Mulata, we will continue along it until a fork that on the left is followed by the road La Mulata and on the right the road to the Tower, we get into this a few meters to park on the left.		
Approach: (machine translated) Accesses bcos Ajoque, Marrubio, Torre and Baranda In both options we will go by the PR-TF58 towards the Risco, we will arrive at the Tagora, to the right goes down the path of the Risco, right next to the Torre ravine and we will go to the left surrounding the cliff. The next channel would be our ravine that has two channels, we will go down the rocky part until we reach the main channel.

Return: (machine translated) At the end of the wall we will go to the right, sticking to the wall to avoid the riverbed full of undergrowth, we will go around this wall to go to the PR that we will take downhill to the car.

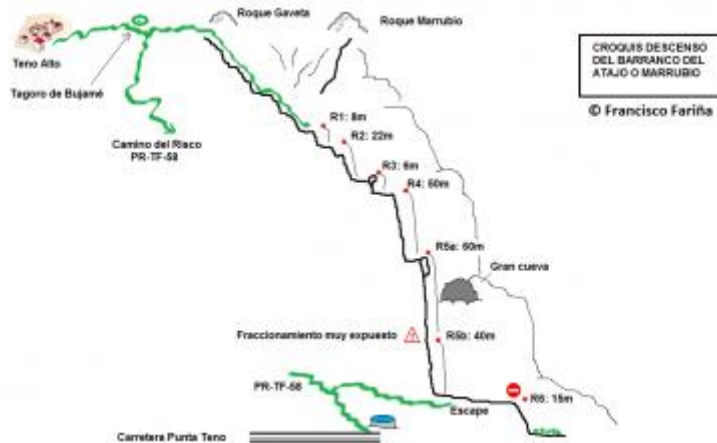
