Summary: (machine translated)

Nice, short and simple ravine in an ideal environment. Generally dry, there are two tributaries to descend, first the right one up to the gorge, we will cross it and then take the other tributary. We will return by the first tributary. Perfect to combine with the bco del Molins, any other activity, or simply to know the area, the flour mills of the seventeenth century, the refrigerator Regatxols, etc..

On the CV15 from Castellón we will go up to Coll d'Ares (pk 53), here we will turn to Ares, in 1 km we are in the village. Without turning off we will arrive at the square where we turn left in search of the Font del Regatxols. In just over a kilometer we will arrive and park there or 150m later on a track that goes right to the abandoned Mas.

Approach: (machine translated)

Access Molins and Cantallops

By the track of the Más, we will continue descending a little to cross a fence, to the right we have Molins.

We will follow to the cut ones, south direction and little by little we turn to the east (left) to meet with the right tributary.

Tour: (machine translated)

A first rapel in the tributary, we will go to the left along the girdle to reach the head of Cantallops. Here we will make 2 more rappels until we reach the bottom

Return: (machine translated)

We will continue along the riverbed until the confluence with the tributary, we turn right to go up the tributary, between small climbs, to the pass of the R16 that we descended previously. We will go to the right along the strip to go upwards this time. We will turn left and follow the wall to the Mas, here we will retrace the access path.


