Relatively short canyon, with good waterfalls and, in rainy season, very interesting. The intermediate section is a bit fattened, the rest is quite open and with the possibility of escaping in many areas. Its only drawback is the long access and return.

On almost the entire route to the access trail

We will go to Ezcaray, for it by the N120 we arrive to Santo Domingo de la Calzada and here crossing the village, we take the LR111.

Once in Ezcaray we follow the signs to the ski resort to leave the village, after crossing the bridge we will be on the LR415 that takes us to Posadas.

Just in Posadas there is a track on the left that goes up to Altuzarra, we will go up to there and park.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Along the path that goes up the stream by its orographic left, soon a detour to the right in continuous ascent that enters the Zunarro stream. Among the forest will come a time when we will go down to cross the stream and see a well-marked path that goes up the right orographic.

When we reach a point where it crosses to the left we will have reached the end of the ravine, we will continue climbing through the forest until we cross the stream again to the orographic right and, following the cairns, without such a marked path, we will overcome the upper waterfalls to enter there.

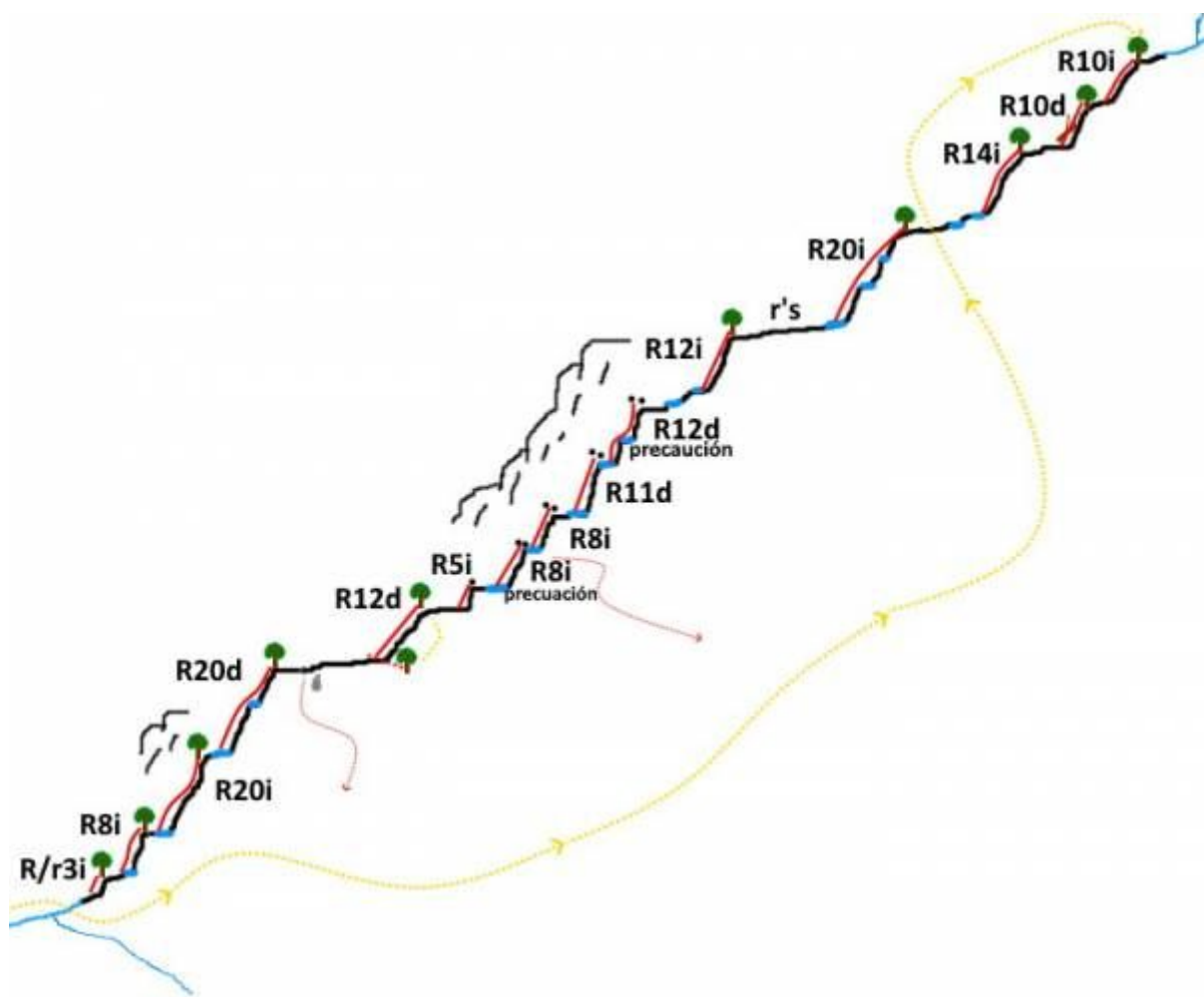
