Short ravine, very boxed and with water only after rains. Perfect to combine with the rest of the area.

Two parts, the upper one with long rappels in ramp, the lower one, very short, is a boxed gorge with 3 rappels that takes us into a corridor that takes us to the access path.

We have to be located in Viguera, on the N111 between Logroño and Soria.

Just at the p.k. 306 we have a track on the right (direction Soria), we get in and park next to it.

Approach: (machine translated)

We will leave by the track towards the Baden ravine, as it enters the ravine narrows and becomes a path.

Accesses bcos Baden, Baden2, Infierno, Helecho and Terrazas Fresno

When we reach the part where it narrows completely we will go through the exit leaving it to the left and soon we have a climb to the left (to the West) by a ravine through which we will climb almost to the top, we will go around some fences and leave the access to the Cascada de la Terraza del Fresno to one side to go almost to the end of the ridge, we will go to the ravine on our left to go down to our ravine.

If we choose to do only the lower part we can access almost opposite the entrance to Baden2 but to the east through a cleft in the mountain that takes us up to the intermediate section.

The upper part is open with two single ramp rappels. The lower part is fattened and very beautiful
