Short but huge canyon with a lot of water. A walk is recommended only at low water! During our walk we had 1.81m³/s

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

Over the Predil Pass on the Slovenian side down towards Bovec. 5.5 km after Log Pod Mangartom you reach Fort Kluze. It is easy to park in front of the bridge.

Approach: (machine translated)

Access is on the orographic right-hand side of the river, at the cavern. An inconspicuous path leads steeply down into the canyon. At the end there are old, desolate wire rope belays and you can also walk the gorge from the top: Follow the hiking trail towards Fort Hermann through the tunnel and turn right at the junction soon after. At the next signpost, turn right onto a somewhat overgrown path that leads directly to the start of the gorge (there used to be a bridge here).

Tour: (machine translated)

Strong currents and turbulent pools alternate in this deep, overwhelming canyon. You should have some whitewater experience and be able to read the current correctly. The pool in front of the jam is potentially dangerous. It is better not to rappel down the 6m waterfall at the exit of the gorge; a long, controlled jump is much safer.

Return: (machine translated)

At the exit of the gorge, on the orographic right, a path leads back up to Fort Kluze.
