Summary: (machine translated)

8 abseiling points from 3 to 32 m - also suitable for beginners.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

Moderately dangerous, you can often walk out via (albeit very steep) paths.

Small watercourses, no pools, the waterfalls require you to wear a full-body suit.

Access: (machine translated)

From Domodossola, drive up the Val Bognanco. Park in the parking lot on the right just before the bridge over Bogna, at the entrance to the hamlet of Fonti. This is also the lower parking lot of Rasiga.

Approach: (machine translated)

Without shuttle: Continue 200 m on foot along the road and after the former Hotel Magenta turn left into a small road (signs "Cascata la Valletta"). After the bridge over Bogna (view of the last waterfall), walk up the right path for 160 m until you reach a stone bench. Climb straight up into the forest on a barely recognizable path without reaching the canyon too soon (so climb slightly to the right). You will come to a building from which a better path leads diagonally to the left up to the dam (Brise Vague), the starting point of the canyon.

From the parking lot above, take a path in front of the oratory towards the stream and then descend as best you can along the torrent to the dam.

Tour: (machine translated)

8 abseils from 3 to 32 m; the two biggest waterfalls are beautiful and a bit wet. MC possible to reach the belays (useful for beginners), only the last C32 (with 1 intermediate point) is obligatory and a bit airy...

Return: (machine translated)

A few meters after the C8, which passes under the bridge, leave the right bank via a steep little path that leads to the old path, just a few meters from the bridge. Cross the stream over the aforementioned bridge to reach the village and then the parking lot.
