**Hydrology:**

**Access:** (machine translated)

We will leave Sant Llorenç de Morunys towards Berga on the LV-4241 road at kilometer 24 of the LV-4241 road, and before passing the river Aigua de Valls (Pont de Valls), there is a road on the left, which we will take.

Car 1:

Continue up the road, which reaches Vilacireres until it becomes a track, ignoring all the roads and tracks that we will find parallel to the river Aigua de Valls, until the track turns left perpendicular to the river. Here we will leave the car to return.

Car 2:

We continue along the track and about 5 kilometers later we will have the parking 2 where if our cars are cars we will have to leave it.

If you have 4x4 or tall cars, you can continue to parking 3 or even continue to Cal Pelegrí.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

If we have parked at Cal Pelegrí it will be just to go down the track to the stream.

If we have parked at P3 or before reaching the stream bed, we will have several tracks and trails to go down to the stream.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

The first part of the course consists of a tree rapell to reach a vertical of 30m, then 2 rappels to reach the Vilacireres river bed.

**Return:** (machine translated)

About 150 - 200m after the last rapell we will see a milestone on the right along a faded path in ascending direction. We will reach the end of a track, we will follow it to the road where we have the cars.
