We will be located in Alcala de Júcar.

Possibility 1:

We take from the village the small road that leads to Tolosa and we will follow it until the end, in the surroundings of the Tranco del Lobo Hydroelectric Power Station a track comes out on the right that goes up for 1,5 kms to turn south already with the ravine on our left. Another 1.5 kms to go around it and reach the parking lot (esplanade near the water reservoir).

Possibility 2:

From the village of La Gila, when entering we will see a track on the right to Casas del Conde. When we get there, we take a track on the left in worse condition that leads us to the track that surrounds the ravine.

Shortly before parking, we will see on our left a track in bad condition that goes down to the riverbed.

When we reach the shore, on the right we will see a path with a rope to ascend and some cables with which to pass an exposed section. The path will continue climbing up to the track where we have parked.

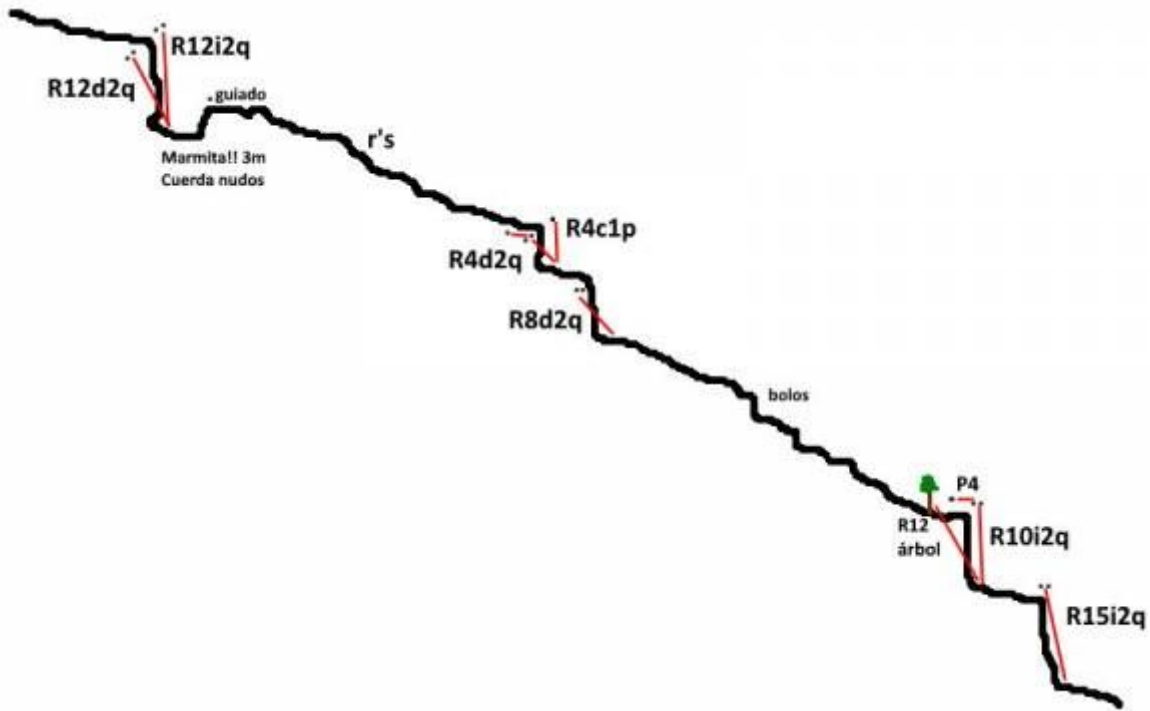
