Summary: (machine translated)

Alpine gorge with some rappels, then longer runs (with downclimb) to the exit.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

We leave the A 8 (Munich-Salzburg) via the Holzkirchen exit. After 17 km on the B 318 in southern direction we reach Gmund. We can now continue on the B 318 along the western shore of Lake Tegernsee via Bad Wiessee or on the B 307 along the eastern shore to Reitrain, where the two roads merge again (about 10 km from Gmund). Now continue south on the B 307 via Kreuth. Passing Wildbad Kreuth and after 4.7 km (from Kreuth) passing a large parking lot for hikers (parking lot for Klammbach or Plattengraben) we come 1.7 km further on the B 307 to the Trifthütte (left of the road). Since the Trifthütte is no longer managed and the access is blocked with an iron barrier, we park about 200m before on the righthand side on an old part of the road.

Approach: (machine translated)

We cross the Weißach on a footbridge and about 150m further we come across a slope, which we follow to the right. We walk 2.4 km on this track (approx. 40 min.), then we come to a prominent right serpentine (1025m altitude), where a path leaves, which leads about 800m further upwards over the steep grassy slopes of the Totengraben (http://www.bromba.com/berge/steige131.htm) (Totengrabensteig). Finally it goes down in some serpentines into the Totengraben. Here we are at a dilapidated Triftklause and at the entry.

Tour: (machine translated)

8 rappels, lots of downclimbing, some possible jumps, longer running sections. First in the Totengraben, then in the Kirchwandgraben, finally in the Albertsbach.

Return: (machine translated)

Before the bridge, turn left onto the forest road. Along the Albertsbach downhill and over the Weißach across to the Trifthütte.

Lots of walking and downclimbing in between. We took the alternative exit just after the Plattengraben comes in on the right, sparing us the last bit of walking in the river. Not great, not bad. Anchors are ok.
