Directly after the bridge we start with 10m rappel, swim and almost 60m multipitch mostly through the water jet.

It is best to take the first steep dry stream on the orographic left. (The cairns in the streambed obviously do not mark exit points, but are intended to encourage further walking in the stream) Alternatively, descend further and take the shuttle back up, but this is not interesting.
