<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Little traveled ravine next to Pano, of comfortable access by track and a somewhat long and hard return. Good descent in rainy season, the rest of the year it is dry. Much better to do it in spring when it has flow.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Yes, although the orography is complicated and the exuberant vegetation complicates escape routes.		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) By the N123 we turn off towards Graus/Benasque by the A139. Or by the N260 at the height of the Colladas towards Graus. At pk 3 we find the detour to Panillo. After passing Panillo, about 3 kms later we have the detour to Puy de Cinca, just in the detour we have on the right the road that goes down to Pano. We will park at the entrance of this beautiful village.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) We will leave by the GR in the direction of the hermitage of San Vicente, we will pass a first riverbed, the Pano gorge and just before climbing to the hermitage of San Vicente we will arrive at our ravine.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Continuous and well configured descent, overhangs (some of them delicate), pools, marmitas and a total of 12 rappels. Generally dry, much better after rain. The final part is the most interesting as the longest rappels are found here.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Once the ravine is finished, we will take a small path to the left, quite steep, that will take us up the slope in an interesting ascent that will lead us to the access path.
