Access: (machine translated) From the Santander - Oviedo road (initially N-632, later N-625), turn south towards Leon at Arriondas (i.e. continue on the N-625) and turn right via Cangas de Onis into the upper Sella Valley (signposted Riano / Leon). About 8 km after passing the village of Santillan, after a bridge (over the Vallegon), a small road turns off to Amieva (signposted). On the right below a somewhat dilapidated inn, where you can park the car below. The road climbs over hairpin bends. After the second series of hairpin bends (about 3 km from the bottom), turn right onto a dirt road with the signs 'uso exclusivo para ...'. Here, on the other side of the road, is the parking lot for the top car (if you have 2 with you).		
Approach: (machine translated) A path leads from the car directly down to the stream (5 min.).		
Tour: (machine translated) Barely incised forest gorge, then 1 km run outside the stream. The 25 m ropes in the lower part (where you can also jump from the right from the middle) are beautiful, otherwise only moderately attractive. After the first part, you should get off at the fixed ropes on the left and only at a bridge below the upper serpentine sequence of the road turn right down to a bridge and there re-enter the streambed		
Return: (machine translated) On the left before the bridge through a fenced yard area or after the bridge.
