Summary: (machine translated)

Also known as Travesseres because this is one of its accesses, it is a beautiful and unknown canyon of the Cerdanya, with a beautiful rapel of 20 meters over a waterfall in the shape of a ponytail.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

Possible by the sides, it is not a closed ravine but the amount of vegetation and the slipperiness of the terrain make progress difficult.

Access: (machine translated)

We will have to be located between La Seu d'Urgell and Puigcerdà. By the N260 we will arrive at Martinet. Here we have several options:

- 1.- With a 4x4 we will be able to approach by the track that leaves behind the cemetery and goes up the Riu de la Llosa until it ends, very close to the exit of the ravine.
 - 2.- With a 4x4 from Travesseres we will go through the village and after the church there is a track that descends, at the first fork we will take left and follow the track that descends to the Riu Llosa in NE direction.
- Without 4x4, we can park in Travesseres (although in the return we will have to go up to here) and follow the track outlined in point 2. Or we can park on the track of the Llosa river (we will go up as far as we can with the car).

Approach: (machine translated)

If we have parked in Travesseres or Martinet, we will have to follow the tracks that lead to the "parking" at the end of the ravine. From this point a few meters ahead we will see a path on the left that climbs to the head of the ravine. After 20 minutes of climbing, the trail turns right and enters the river valley until it crosses it. Time to access.

Tour: (machine translated)

Little known, with multiple projections, lots of vegetation and a waterfall of 20m really beautiful. We can secure some of the projections in the natural ones since it is a very slippery canyon. There are only 3 obligatory rappels.

Return: (machine translated)

There is an irrigation channel on the right that we follow and then leave to go right towards the access road.
