Summary: (machine translated) Open rappel canyon with cold water. Old gold mine in the canyon		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Drive along the Anza Valley to the village of Macugnaga. It is best to park in the parking lot in the village.		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow the path down to the river, then turn right past the houses and over the bridge. Follow the hiking trail to the left immediately after the bridge. After about 30 minutes, descend left at the old houses to the water catchment.		
Tour: (machine translated) Rappel canyon with mostly old stands; partly thin chain links as is "usual" here. The anchors are sometimes rather unfortunate; (pull-off problems!!) In the canyon there are old mining tunnels (gold mining). Especially the 2nd entrance (rather in the lower third on the right side) is worth a visit (headlamp!!) You can easily walk around in the tunnel for 30 minutes. Rather cool tour, so ideal when it is too hot everywhere else		
Return: (machine translated) There is an old suspension bridge on the left. Cross it to reach the dilapidated houses of the mine and the parking lot. Alternatively, if you don't want to cross the old bridge, you can walk back to the access path above the river.

Much longer than expected, it took us ~4 hours entering by the upper shaft (N45.95384, E8.01914). This can be easily accessed through the woods, and even an old rope is there to get in the streambed. The canyon must have been recently rerigged, we found no problem, however, the topo posted here previously has very faint connection to reality, i.e. an unexpected 50m cascade came close to the end. The lower goldmine really worth a visit! The old bridge can be used with minimum courage.
