Access: (machine translated) To descend the Myloi canyon, we can park all cars on the coastal road at the exit point, which is a 5-minute walk from the exit. To reach the entrance on foot requires a pleasant, slightly uphill hike of about an hour. If there is an off-road vehicle in the group, we can drive up to the entrance of the canyon more quickly, especially if we want to combine this with another descent on the same day to Gerakina Gorge, a little further down the road near the village of Schinos.
