<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Neighboring ravine of Eriste and that ends in it, just at the bridge of Tamarrius. It is much less known than Eriste because it attracts all the attention. Its flow is just as high but the lower height of its rappels and being more open makes it more accessible.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) In the narrows by the commented access path. At the dam also at the end of the aquatic part.		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Take the N260 to Castejón de Sos, where we turn off to Benasque on the A139. We will go to the village of Eriste. If we can, we will go up the forest track that goes up to Espigantosa (almost at the end of Eriste it comes out on the left), up to the Tamarrius bridge. Keep in mind that in summer time the ascent is regulated.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) We cross the bridge and see a post indicating the path of the Aigüeta de la Vall on the right. We go up leaving aside the dam of the catchment (end of the aquatic part of the ravine). Continue uphill until you find a detour (approx. 40min) that leads you to the straits (possible escape). We continue uphill until beyond the forest where we see a milestone to go down to the river.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) The first part is very aquatic up to the catchment and the second part is dry, except when it is strong.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) At the dam, the end of the aquatic part, we can exit by a metal ladder. If we continue, at the end of the last rappels there is a path on the right that leads to the bridge.
