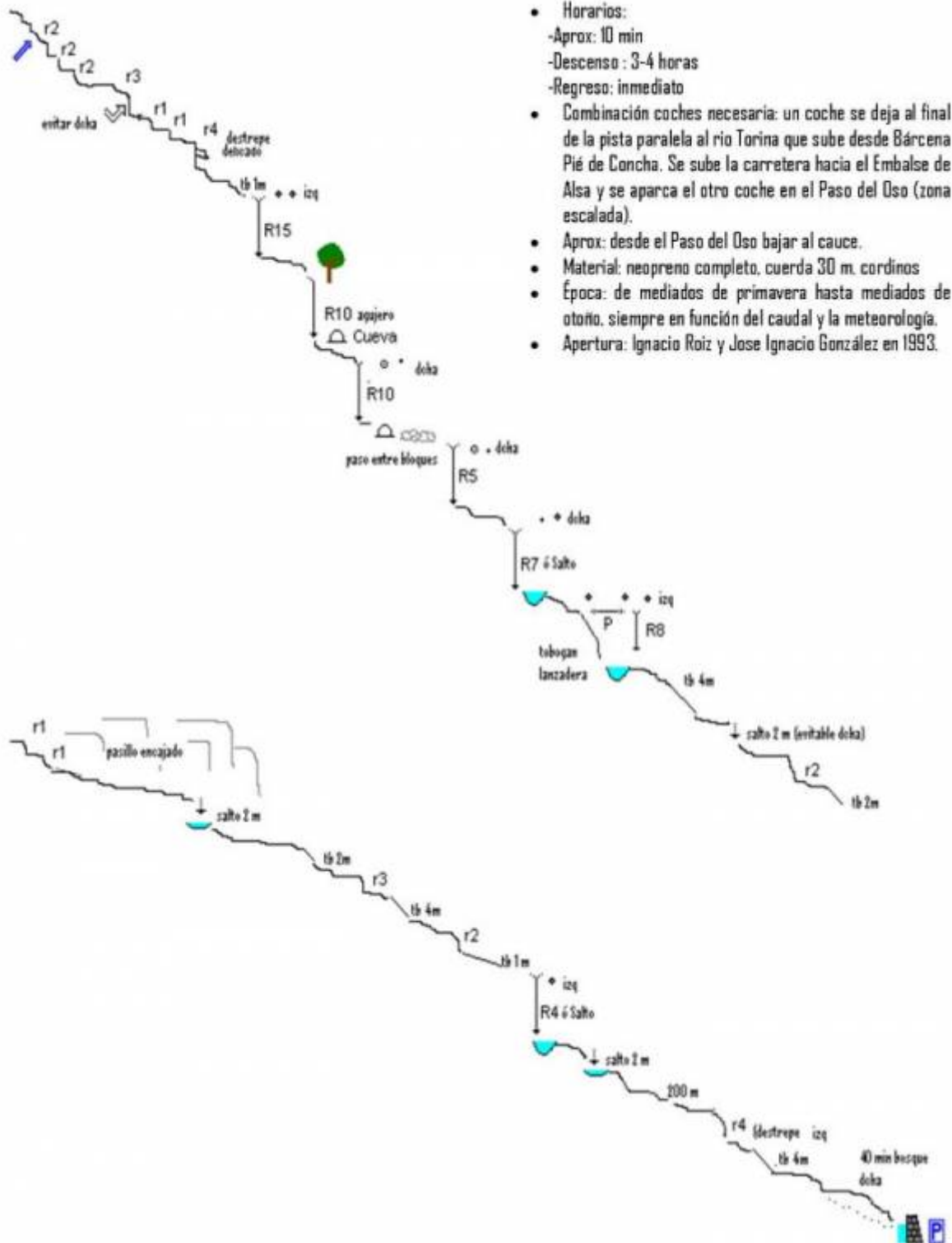

<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Nice ravine but quite difficult to develop by the amount of logs and undergrowth that can be found.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Quite difficult, but some of the skills can be avoided.		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From the A67 we take the N611 to Bárcena de Pie de Concha. Once in the village we have to pass under the national road by the CA716 towards the Torina power station, we turn right towards the power station and a few meters to the left going up the river towards the river walk. Here we leave the exit car. With the other car we continue climbing towards the reservoir until we reach the pass (Paso del Oso).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the pass we will follow a small path that goes down through the cliffs to the river.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Lots of cliffs, some slides and lots of undergrowth and logs. Be careful with the anchors!		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) After the last rapel, we will soon be able to exit to the right onto the trail.

## BARRANCO DEL RÍO TORINA



- Horarios:
  - Aprox: 10 min
  - Descenso: 3-4 horas
  - Regreso: inmediato
- Combinación coches necesaria: un coche se deja al final de la pista paralela al río Torina que sube desde Bárcena Pié de Concha. Se sube la carretera hacia el Embalse de Alsa y se aparca el otro coche en el Paso del Oso (zona escalada).
- Aprox: desde el Paso del Oso bajar al cauce.
- Material: neopreno completo, cuerda 30 m, cordinos
- Época: de mediados de primavera hasta mediados de otoño, siempre en función del caudal y la meteorología.
- Apertura: Ignacio Roiz y Jose Ignacio González en 1993.
