"Natural" forest canyon with lots of walking and downclimbing, plus some rapells and slides.

From Bilbao, we first take the AP-68 to exit 3, then the A-2522 to Orozko (about 20 km in total). From Orozko we continue to Ibarra (4 km). From Ibarra we drive in a south-easterly direction to Usabel Auzoa. At the junction we take the right-hand road, a few meters further on at the next junction we take the left branch. 650 m after this junction and 4 km from Usabel the road crosses "our" stream. We park our car here for the exit.

Continue uphill in the second car and after 2.6 km (from the bridge) you will come to a sharp left-hand bend in the road. Here we turn right to a picnic area. We park the top car at the roadside.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

From the parking lot, we march on indistinct tracks through the young forest, first in a westerly direction, then in a south-westerly direction uphill to the meadows. Here we head for the orographic right branch of the Barrancon and then look for the entry point.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

First a vertical part with 5 rapells, then a longer run and finally the river walk in the last part with some smaller rapells and slides.

**Return:** (machine translated)

On reaching the road bridge out to the car.

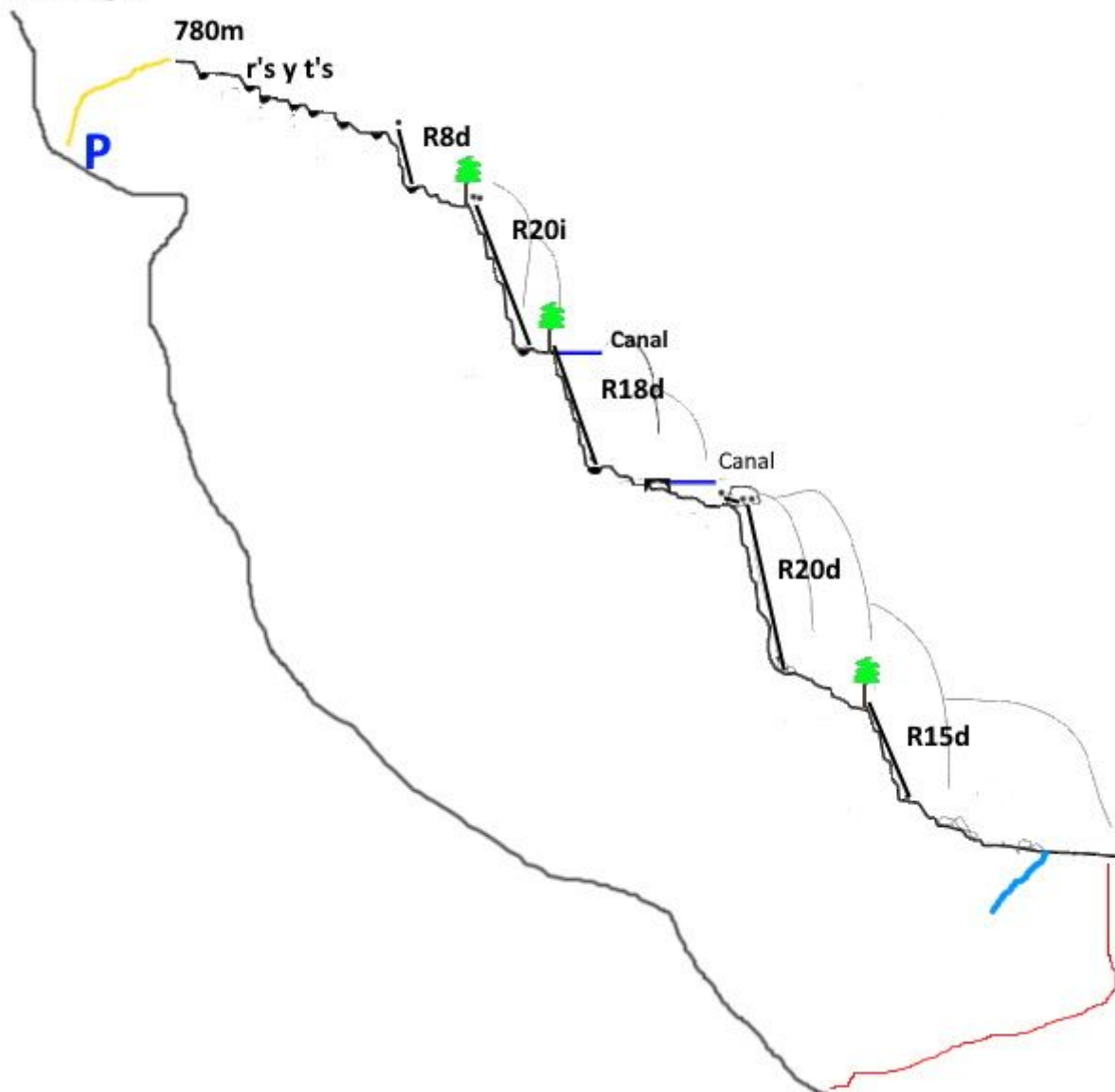
