Summary: (machine translated) Aquatic rappel canyon in granite.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) First as to Pacoulla, cf. http://www.map-erlebnis.de/canyoning-topo/canyoning-torrente-pacoulla/ . However, we do not drive through to Fontainemore at first, but park the car for the exit near the bridge over the Torrente Bouro. The bridge is reached on the SR44 about 1.5 km after Lilianes and 9.4 km from the highway exit Pont Saint Martin (see Google maps "approach" in photo gallery). With the second car we continue to the access to Pacoulla (see there), cross the stream and about 150m further keep half-left at the road junction up to the hamlet of Chuchal (see Google maps "Implementation" in photo gallery). We park the second car in the immediate vicinity of Torrente Bouro.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the car in a few steps to the stream. If we do not have a second car for a transfer, we walk from the bridge at the exit about 300m back along the road in a northerly direction and then turn right onto a path. It leads us to a farmstead. Here begins a path (yellow markings) that takes us to the entry at the hamlet of Chuchal.		
Tour: (machine translated) 8-10 rappel. See topographic view and photos at the web links. You can also continue down the stream to the next road bridge (740m altitude). See topographic view.		
Return: (machine translated) Before the road bridge out to the right and to the car.

We went up to the right of the meadow but only found a steep invisible path . As soon as we saw the house we started walking in that direction with no path . This was pretty steep. After we got to the house we saw a better path leading to the river. The canyon itself das very beautiful however some comments. The anchors are not very well placed. The first relay (mc) on the right was difficult to reach. We had to use a human anchor to get to the relay safely. Afterwards we saw relays that were damaged and broken steel cables that were in the maillons of the relays. These steel cables had no use and were annoying. They're More likely to damage the rope .
