Summary: (machine translated) Open rappel canyon in tuff, also suitable for beginners. Long access / very overgrown. Overall not worthwhile.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Either from Ventimiglia on the SS 20 in the direction of Breil-sur-Roya, Tende, Cuneo and after about 12 km, immediately after a long tunnel turn right in the direction of Airole or coming from the north (Breil-sur-Roya) after 13 km (from Breil) immediately before the tunnel and the road bridge over the Roya turn left in the direction of Airole. We drive up at the first houses on the left into the village and park the car there.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the central square (church on the left and fountain in the middle) in Airole, head east up the road (Via Garibaldi) with the stair-like flat steps (signposts "Rocchetta" and "Basse d'Abellio"). We are now on "Sentiero 1" on the internet map (CWiki). We soon turn left at the first signpost (towards Monte Abellio; to the right would take us to Valle Para), a few meters further on we turn right. We now follow the path uphill, which is marked with white and red markings. Passing a fountain, we come to the road to Fasceo, leave it again after a few meters to the left (towards Monte Abellio) to climb steeply up to the small saddle ("Croce del Coletto"), from where we have a beautiful (rear) view of Airole and the Roya Valley. Follow the path for about 250 m, then turn left onto a small path that runs horizontally along the slope. We walk along this path for about half an hour and then come to the ruined houses of Case Sorvan (460 m above sea level). We pass the first ruined house and a few meters further on take a poorly visible path to the left, which we follow downhill through the trees to the stream (430 m a.s.l.). Folléas-Giminez describe an access path always close to the stream and we enter about 130 m further down (300 m a.s.l.).		
Tour: (machine translated) Sequence of smaller rappels, some with possible jumps, running routes in between.		
Return: (machine translated) At the height of a small dam with a large water reservoir below (ENEL), we climb out to the left onto a poor path, join another path coming down from the left and then come to a road which we follow into Airole. A further descent is not recommended because of the water catchment and the somewhat smelly water from it.

It became dry, so it was all just a matter of walking along the stream or avoiding muddy puddles. There were 2-3 nice dry abseils until we reached the lower path after an hour, which we then followed out of the gorge. Since the path crosses the stream twice more, you can see that the lower section isn't worth it either. You really don't have to do it!!! We were cursing for 2h35 on the way, but we reached the mountain pass so quickly. When we arrived, there was a little water flowing, but it didn't look like a canyon. It got dry, all just creek hiking or bypassing dirt pools, there were 2-3 nice dry abseils until we reached the lower path after 1h, which we then followed out of the canyon. As you cross the stream twice along the way, you can see that the lower part isn't worth it either. You really don't have to do it!!! (machine translated)
