Summary: (machine translated) Simple canyon, almost initiation (caution must be taken with spring flows), short but of extraordinary beauty, it is perfect to combine with the Bco Gordo in the same day without having to move the car. The perfect option if Liri is going strong. Easy access and return.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Very difficult, it's quite rugged		
Access: (machine translated) We have to place ourselves in Castejón de Sos Access to Bcos Chico and Gordo By the N260 from Castejón de Sos to Pont de Suert, after a few kilometers we arrive at the crossroads of "Liri 5 km" on the left. We will go up this road until almost the town of Liri, past Arasán we will see a track on the right that takes us up to a pass that is used for paragliding. A little more than 1km later there is a sharp bend (180 degrees) on the right and a place to park. Another option is to park in the village of Liri and access by the return of the bco Gordo.		
Approach: (machine translated) Approaches Bcos Chico and Gordo From the curve we go straight ahead on a path that crosses a meadow towards the Alassets ravine, after crossing it, the path rises slightly to find the Bco Chico. If we leave from Liri we will go along the return track of the Bco Gordo and after passing it we continue straight ahead until we reach a curve where we have a path on the right that goes down to the ravine.		
Tour: (machine translated) Simple, well dug and very nice descent. We will have to be cautious with high flows that in the boxed zone the water takes a lot of force.		
Return: (machine translated) When we reach the confluence with Alassets we will exit to the left a little below the tributary. We will see a path and cairns that will take us to the track where we park. If we have left the car in Liri we will have to follow the riverbed a little more and we go out to the right under the steep slopes in search of the bco Gordo by a not very marked path. we will cross it and soon we arrive at the village.


