**Summary:** (machine translated)

Impressive canyon cut into the porphyry; challenging in length and water level, with a spectacular 130 m high waterfall at the exit. Normally the upper part is not accessible due to the high water level, except in particularly dry periods. The middle section begins below the exit from the upper part. The entire Rio Sinigo, from Hafling to the village of Sinigo, is certainly the most impressive canyon in South Tyrol, with around 50 equipped abseils or downclimbs over a length of more than 4 km.

**Hydrology:** (machine translated)

Only accessible in particularly dry periods. Otherwise not accessible due to the high water level.

**Access:** (machine translated)

Shuttle 13,5km

Approach to the parking exit: from Bolzano Sud take the Merano-Bolzano expressway in the direction of Merano. Then take the Sinigo/Sinich exit and continue towards this village. After the long straight, take the first exit at the traffic circle in the direction of Arelengo/Verano Hafling/Vöran. After approx. 1 km, at another traffic circle, take the first exit Pictung Freiberg/Montefranco (Via Castel Gatto). Follow the road for approx. 2 km until you reach the junction al Hohe 523 (crucifix) and turn left into Via #ers and then into Via Fragsburg/Castel Verruca Ge in the direction of Fragsburg. After about 3 km, drive past Fragsburg Castle and then park your car (BOTTOM CAR) in the unpaved parking lot. From here, a wide path begins on the right that leads to the Fades 130 m high waterfall in 15 minutes, where you can judge the water level.

Parking entry. From Fragsburg Castle, drive back to the junction with Via Labers and follow it to the right. At the exit of Via Labers, take the first exit at the traffic circle in the direction of Hafling When you reach the village of Hafling, turn left before the E55o petrol station and park directly above the petrol station (Nusser parking lot).

**Approach:** (machine translated)

From the parking lot, walk down and follow Via Locher for about 150 meters. Then take the wide path on the right that leads up the Sinigo stream to a small bridge. After crossing this small bridge, descend to the river bed on the orographic left bank and follow the watercourse until you reach a large stone wall, where the route begins.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Difficult canyon for normal water flow. Risk of landslides and falling rocks. The route is divided into three parts: upper part, rarely passable due to strong current; middle part, generally passable and fairly open; lower part, often with little water, but becomes dangerous in strong current.

C135 (35-20-20-50)

Emergency exit near the first tributary on the left.

Remarks: it is recommended to bring your own material to reinforce inadequate anchors. Check the water level very carefully!

**Return:** (machine translated)

After the 130-meter-high waterfall, follow the water inlet to the right and ascend above it on the path to Fragsburg Castle.

Beautiful and challenging canyon in very wild environment, for experts. Presence of numerous fallen logs in water, useful hacksaw. We added 2 missing anchors along the route. The last 135 mt rappel has 2 takes (35 mt, 30 mt, 60 mt) beware that ropes can get stuck. Currently all anchors are recent and in good condition. Recommended rigging bag and to be done only after long dry periods and in stable weather. Only 1 escape route in the first part of the canyon. (machine translated)
