Canyon with quite bad rock quality, a nice 40m rappel ending and a 28m rappel will delight lovers of the great verticals. Dry except for heavy rains

We will have to be located in Pizarra where we will arrive from Malaga by the A357.

Just arriving to Pizarra, in the p.k. 21,4 we have an exit to the right that we will take to continue towards Fuente Luna (there are indicators of PR-A 128).

The other option is from the village of Pizarra to go up towards the soccer field and behind it take the Guadalhorce street, from there a track towards Fuente Luna.

By the track that goes up to the Santo, just when we are arriving at the top we will have a sharp bend to the left and we will see our ravine on the right, shortly after we parked.

The car of return, we will leave it in the crossing of tracks of Fuente Luna.

Evident from the track we descend to the right towards the bed of our ravine, we will look for the best way to descend.

Once finished, we turn right onto a path/track that leads down to the main track and then right to the car.

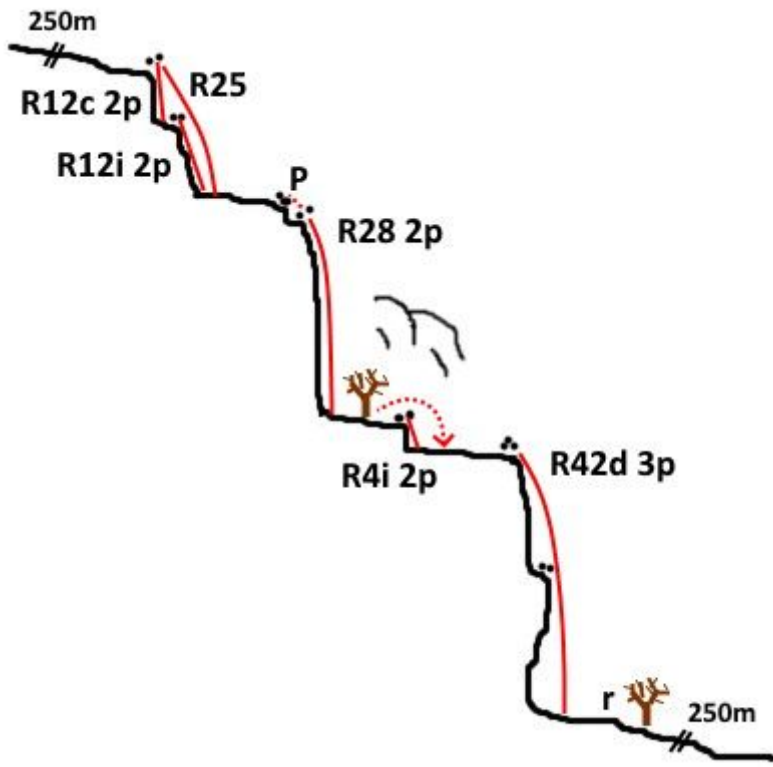
