Take the N260 to Castejón de Sos, where we turn off to Benasque on the A139.

We cross Benasque and continue along the road. After passing the Cerler traffic circle we will go up to the Paso Nuevo reservoir, just when it ends we have on the right the Senarta Plan, where we can camp, take the bus that goes up to Coronas, etc.

On the other side we turn right and after 100m we take the track to the left that goes up to Vallibierna, to the refuge of Coronas, we will stay before in the Cabaña de Quillón.

Approach: (machine translated)

We will continue along the track to the source of the Esmoladera, here on the left is a path of white markings that goes down to the river, crosses it and climbs through the forest until it ends and we reach a small hill. From here it is already evident the riverbed to descend, we will go down towards it little by little.

Tour: (machine translated)

Open at first, until the first rapel, from here it narrows until it becomes a very well formed narrow corridor in which the force of the water can put us in trouble (evaluate the flow well). We will continue until we reach the Vallibierna river.

Return: (machine translated)


We will go out to the right to cross the river in search of some white marks that will lead us to a path, this path will leave us on the GR track.
