Coming from the north, we take the B11 via Schmid-von-Kochel-Platz and then head south along Mittenwalder Straße. On the right we see the Schmid-von-Kochel monument, the Raiffeisenbank and next to it the Pfleger butcher's shop. Opposite is Kalmbachstraße, which we turn into. After a good 100m, we turn right into Alte Straße. After another 700m, we turn half-left into Straße am Sonnenstein and after another 400m we come to the edge of the forest, where we park our car.\nNavi input: "Kochel am See - Am Sonnenstein 24" or "Sonnensteinweg 11"; GPS: N 47°38'39.62" E 11°22'13.62" (altitude 655m)

Approach: (machine translated)

We follow the "Sonnenspitz" signposts and walk up the forest road above the Lainbach stream. After 110m, the road crosses the Laingraben and climbs relatively steeply up the slope on the other side. After 2.5 km (from the bridge) we come to a clearing (GPS; N 47°38'39.62" E 11°23'08.60" - altitude 1005m), where the path to Sonnenspitz branches off to the right (signpost). There is a bench on the left at the edge of the path. Here we take the forest road that leads down to the left to the Lainbach (entry).\n\nThe approach on the forest road can be shortened via a path (signpost - Kot-Alm (?) - after the bridge over the Lainbach).\nYou can also reach the entry via the orographic right side of the slope.\n

Tour: (machine translated)

We start with a river walk. After a while, it is interrupted at regular intervals by steps, some of which are rappelled, but mostly downclimbed. There is also a possible jumps. Almost at the exit of the tour and about 200m before the final waterfall, we see an overgrown path to the left (exit possible). The following block section in the stream can be bypassed righthand side in the forest. The tour exits at the Upper Lainbach Falls (GPS: N 47°38'59.96" E 11°22'54.73" altitude 795m)

We get out onto the wooden path and walk down to the car.
