Coming from France (Perpignan) on the A-7 highway, leave it at the Figueres (Nord) exit and drive through the city onto the N-260 towards Olot, Ripoll, and at Olot turn onto the C-152, later the C-153 towards Vic. At first the road is flat, later it climbs steeply and after about 30 km (from Olot) you reach the turn-off (left = south) to Rupit. There is a large parking lot before Rupit. Turn right here, drive over the bridge (the river is the Rio or Riera de Rupit) and slowly descend on the road (approx. 2 km) until you come to a large plateau on the left, where it makes sense to park the car if you do not have a four-wheel drive vehicle.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the parking area, continue eastwards down the slope and soon you will be looking at a cauldron of imposing rocky outcrops ('Guillerias') up to 100 m high. You now cross the Rio de Rupit again - here begins the canyon Salt de Sallent de Rupit down to the right - and continue to follow the slope until a path on the right leads down to the entry into the Gravet. A little later you reach the streambed of the Ravet with the first rappel point.

Tour: (machine translated)

Short canyon with a beautiful 30 m rappel (5 rappels in total) in a magnificent setting. If at the beginning Wsser flows, it may soon seep.

Return: (machine translated)

After the last abseiling point with a larger pool, work your way down through boulders for another 50 m until you come to a path that crosses the stream (cairn on a larger boulder). Follow the path to the right (westwards) and continue along it under the rock faces until the entire path, clearly recognizable by the paving, leads in serpentines up to the plateau (approx. 25 min. to here). From here it is about 10 minutes back to the car.
