Summary: (machine translated) Dry canyon except after heavy rains, somewhat long approach but the canyon is worth it. Perfect to combine with any of the area		
Hydrology: (machine translated) In most of the course, it is very open		
Access: (machine translated) Crevillente ravines situation By the A7 we go to Crevillente. If we go from Alicante we leave by the N340 we enter the town. Situation parking and access to Crevillente ravines Just at the entrance of Crevillente we take the first street on the right, a wide avenue that leads us to the north of the village, we pass by the health center leaving it on the left. We will continue straight ahead and then take some streets to the left in search of Calle Molinos. We will leave the village leaving the Hermitage of Sant Pascual on the left, we continue along the same road towards "Els Pontets" we will continue straight ahead for 1 km where we will park.		
Approach: (machine translated) Access to Barbereta and Alquitrá ravines We will leave by the winding path that goes up to Pi de Alivi, we can also climb more smoothly by the PR CV109 following its marks. After the pine tree the path turns left to climb the rest of the hill to the top of the mountain range through a small pine forest. When we reach the top we will see a signpost and go towards the Vella, with the pine forest on our right and views to the south of the entire basin of our ravine. Just before reaching the Vella we find a track that comes to our right, time to leave the heights and throw us to the left to the ravine. On the orographic left we will see a path little marked by which we will go down until we find the first rappel.		
Tour: (machine translated) Open descent, close to the Alquitrá with numerous rappels, many of which can be climbed. It is a descent with no difficulty that can be used to initiate the descent.		
Return: (machine translated) Just before arriving at the Alquitrà lake we will find a track on the left that we will take to the car. We can also do the last stretch of Alquitrá.
