<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Short canyon of great unevenness. 4 rappels in a row for 132 meters. The longest in the area (72 meters), which can be divided into two (42 + 30), is done over a large yellow waterfall, visible from all around. The inhospitable of the place, makes that some zones can be considered as small jungles, where it is necessary to be moving away the vegetation that leaves to our step. Terrain for adventure in the Serranía de Cuenca. Better to do it in spring, or after heavy rains, to enjoy the great yellow wash.

<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) By the CM-210 to Puente de Vadillos, here we park a car. If we have two cars, with the second one we will go to the exit of the ravine to take the detour to the right towards Solán de Cabras. Shortly before arriving, there is a forest track on the right where we can continue to the Cuervo river or park wherever we can.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the entrance of Puente de Vadillos, a forest track goes up to the crest of the mountain, follow it up to the top and then take a path to the left along the "crest" in a south-easterly direction until you reach the cut of the ravine.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Short but intense ravine		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) We follow the ravine to the Cuervo River.

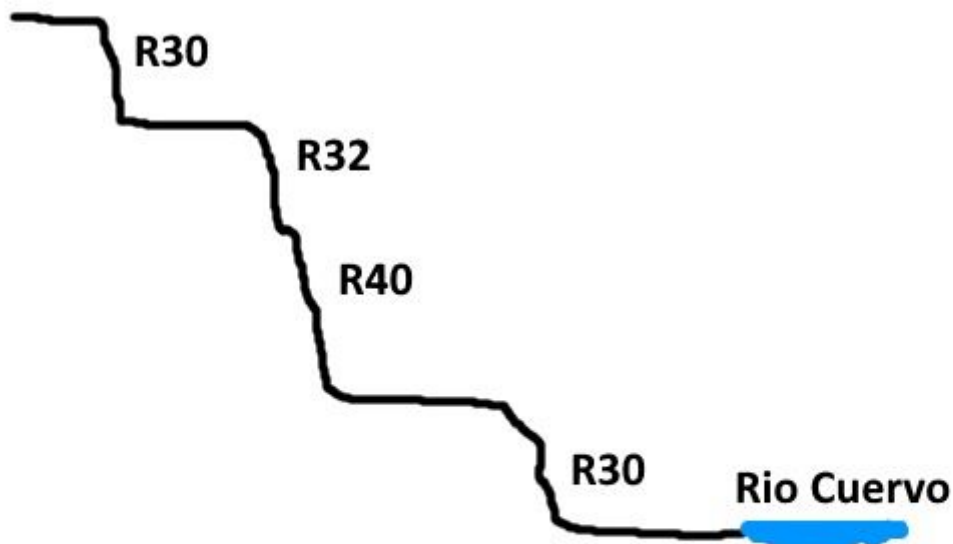
