We approach Otxandio on the N240, here we will head towards Dima on the BI2543. At the height of the Alto de Dima there is an airfield on the right and parking area.

On the track that goes straight ahead (to the north) to Arkabela. We follow the track along the left bank of the ravine ascending slightly. We will arrive at a crossroads where we must continue to the left to follow the ravine, soon the track descends to the head of the ravine.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Shortly after starting and after a couple of climbing skills we arrive at the Erreka waterfall, there are several chained rappels that can be done with a rope of 40m or split. Beware of slipping, with poor quality rock and trees to make natural.

The open nature of the canyon will take away some of the ambience, as well as the several areas of kicking that are several.

After the big waterfall we will only have some rappels of up to 10m, some slides and a lot of climbing and kicking.


