Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Césane at the foot of the Montgenèvre pass, take the road from Bousson along the river. At the Bousson exit, take the road on the right to Thures. Just before Thures, at a leftward hairpin bend where there are garbage cans, go straight along the small road that leads to the hamlet of Rhuelles. The road becomes a good path. Cross Rhuelles and continue straight on. After 1.5 km, the road forks: right leads to the exit, left to the access.		
Approach:		
Tour: (machine translated) Entry C10 from a tree into a small pool C8 over a tree trunk lying in the waterfall C6 DES Set 2 or new rakes and use as C2 mini slide DES 2 Chaos, walk a longer distance and occasionally downclimb C8 into a shallow pool 1m Jump - L-jump, the pool is moderately deep DES 5 Lots of dead wood in the water C19 C6 C3 C5 DES 5 DES 5
