Simple canyon ideal for beginners. It has several short rappels, a couple of slides and a spectacular 22m final rappel. The access is immediate and the return is very short.

You have to get to Jorox, Alozaina neighborhood.

To do this, if we go from Marbella we take the A355 to Ojen. We pass this village and when we get to Monda we turn left towards Guaro on the A7100. Until the junction with the A366 to Alozaina.

If we are coming from Malaga we must take the A357 towards Cártama, until we reach Zalea where we take the A354. We will follow it until Alozaina

Once in Alozaina we continue on the A366 to Yuqueras. Halfway we will pass the viewpoint of Jorox and then we take the detour to the left to the neighborhood of Jorox. Upon arrival we will see the bar on the right and parking space on the left where the fence.

Approach:

Inmediato.

Tour: (machine translated)

Simple descent that begins with small rappels and skills, until arriving at the 22m rappel.

"A diverter has been mounted on the R3 on the orographic left over a natural. It helps to get out of the active and leaves you on a plate from which to make a jump to avoid entering the siphon.

We have dived the siphon and in principle there is no problem through the window, but further to the right if it pushes against the bottom (drosage)."

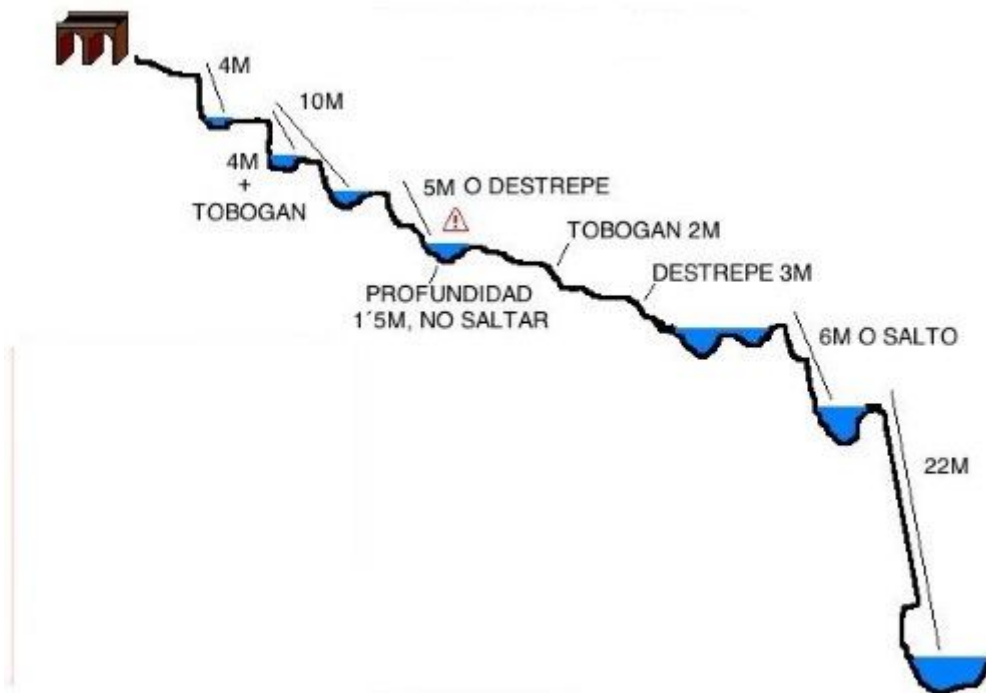
