Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful canyon. Probably the first canyon in the area. Unfortunately only interesting after a lot of rain. Dry almost all year round; stagnant water in pools; very slippery; many rappels in mostly small pools; 35m rappel with sharp edges.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Torbole towards Malcesine --> continue along the road (249) through the village of Brenzone to the small village of "Pai" (between Torri del Benaco and Castello di Brenzone) --> turn left there towards Pai di Sopra (Via Manzoni) --> drive up to the village over cobblestones --> past the bar and pizzeria --> towards Via Ca. Pai di Sopra (Via Manzoni) --> drive up to the village over cobblestones --> past a bar and pizzeria --> towards Via Ca. Tronconi (dead end) --> after approx. 1.5km there is a bridge --> cross it and park at the 2nd church pillar at approx. 250m (little space for parking).		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot follow the road for 15 minutes in the direction of Ca Tronconi> over a bridge >past the olive trees to the first group of houses --> after the group of houses continue right up to the next group of houses at approx. 380m --> here also right --> follow the path along the stone wall, first straight then slightly uphill to the streambed --> entry at approx. 490m.		
Tour: (machine translated) After a short walking passages the first rappels come, which are usually 10 to 15m high --> after approx. 5/6 rappels comes the highest rappel with approx. 35m (! Sharp edges!) --> the route continues continuously in a narrowing canyon over several rappels, which are often up to 20m high --> small sections can also be climbed using the straddle technique --> however, caution is advised as there are slippery spots everywhere due to the vegetation. Small sections can also be downclimbed using the straddle technique --> however, caution is advised as there are slippery spots everywhere due to the vegetation --> in the last third the canyon becomes even narrower and several rappels follow at short intervals until the end --> after the last rappel it continues over small climbing and walking passages for approx. 50m to the exit of the canyon (stone wall).		
Return: (machine translated) At the stone wall on the right, go up over the olive tree slopes --> shortly you will reach the access path --> down to the parking lot.
