We must be located in Eratsun.

On the NA170 between Leitza and Doneztebe, at km. 16.4 we have the detour by NA4031 to Eratsun.

We cross the Ezcurra river and just at kilometer 1 we have a very sharp left curve, on the right a track that crosses our river.

Approach: (machine translated)

Access to the Basakais and Aneskula ravines

We go up the ravine by its orographic left following the path, we will leave behind the confluence with Aneskula and shortly after we will overcome the 25m waterfall, moment to be able to enter.

Tour: (machine translated)

Open, very slippery and full of logs. Facilities in natural.

After the confluence we have more fattened areas, beautiful and better formations of travertine but without waterfalls of so much importance.

Return: (machine translated)

After the confluence we can exit to the left along the path or continue along the "narrow" sections. We will go to the bridge next to the road and the curve of the road.
