Summary: (machine translated) Short but vertical canyon with a magnificent natural mountain.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Very aquatic, considering the equipment as an active factor. Requires excellent mastery of the ropes and fall lines. It is difficult to give an aquatic rating depending on whether you take the active factor into account or not, with A3 being an average. The flow rate is always very generous with a low water level of around 150 l/s. No deep pools.		
Access: (machine translated) From Nice, head north into the Tineetal valley (D 2205 towards Isola) as far as Saint-Sauveur-sur-Tinée. After the village, turn left towards Roubion. Follow the road. After you have seen Roubion on the hillside, take a 180° bend straight ahead for about 1km and after a 90° right-hand bend you will see houses on the right-hand side of the road. Park at the roadside after the houses.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the road, turn right along a barely visible path into the canyon.		
Tour: (machine translated) At first the canyon runs through the forest, then becomes increasingly canyoned and vertical. At C55 you can rappel through the water on the left or dry on the right. This is followed by several abseils on very slippery rock. At medium to high water levels, some of the pools can develop backwaters. Always check well before rappelling. Rope traverses often have to be installed to reach the stands.		
Return: (machine translated) The tour exits at the tributary of the Vionène. The Vionène must be crossed! Check the water level for this too. On the opposite side, walk approx. 100 m to the left until you see a clear path on the opposite bank of the river. Cross the Vionène again here and follow the path to the road. At the road, turn left and follow the road to the car. - Parking lot downhill: Take a leisurely walk up the road. - Parking lot above: Either get out at the parking lot below and the bravest walk up the road without a backpack; or, after leaving the canyon, climb up the right bank of the Vionène, follow a path that leads to a ruin and then walk through chestnut and hazelnut trees to the road, with a steep path towards the exit (equipped by the CG06).
