Barranco if we do it with water, little visited on the south side of Port del Comte, 3 parts, the first generally dry, the second with water in spring and autumn, the lower with less interest. Some people consider it as a collector and if we do it in summer we will take this idea with us, but if we are able to find it with good flow we will change our perspective.

Access: (machine translated)

We will leave Sant Llorenç de Morunys towards Coll del Jou.

If we have two vehicles, with the access vehicle we will take the track that goes to El Montnou and Prat de Bacies. We follow this track for more than 3km until we cross the stream, if we are going to do the middle part we will park here. If we want to do the upper part we follow the track 400m to some ruins where there is another track on the right, from here we will go up to the Prat, when we get to the top, after the left curve, we can park in the soft right curve from which the stream begins.

The return car can be left after the bridge that crosses the ravine, or at the turnoff to Canalda. If we want to do the lower part we will continue 300m more to take the small road that goes down to Canalda, where we will park. With a single vehicle it is best to leave it at the Coll de Jou.

Approach: (machine translated)

Immediate the top and a half parking in their accesses.

If we park in the Coll de Jou we have to take the aforementioned Montnou track and walk up.


