<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Impressive descent almost unknown, with about 30 rappels of up to 50m high and some, like the last one, with spectacular overhangs. Long, good formations, rappels of all colors... It lacks nothing. If we opt for a combination of cars we will save us a good walk uphill.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> Si		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We must be located in the Portillo de la Sía, on the Cantabrian side. The return car, from the village of Veguillas on the CA256, we turn off to Villar on the CA663, here we turn left towards Espinilla, here we turn right to Otero and continue to Otero. From here there is a track that at times is cemented and that goes up to the meadows. We will try to climb as much as we can, at the bottom, in the cirque, the track divides in two, on the right goes up to some pastures and on the left goes down to others where we will leave the ravine. With the access car we will go up to the port of the Sía, in the port we have a track to the left that takes us towards the mills, we surround them and we arrive at an esplanade next to the head of our ravine.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) We leave in a NW direction, seeing clearly which will be our riverbed to descend, in 5-10 min we arrive at the headwaters.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) An endless number of waterfalls, each time higher and higher until reaching the R50 at the end and the R25 that ends the canyon.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) We will find a path that we will take to the left to go up the slope a little, here we will have two options, to the right the hut and the track where we have the car back. If we return to the left, we will go up the slope to the ridge, we will follow it to approach the mills and from here to the car.
