Short but intense canyon with interesting verticals.

Hydrology: (machine translated)

The path is on the orographic left practically all the way down, an area with a steep slope and beech leaves, it can be very slippery if it is wet.

Access: (machine translated)

To get to the ravine we will go to the town of Aisa (Huesca), once there we will go to the bottom of the Valley of Aisa, once past the Sibiscal waterfall, visible from the road (ideal ravine to combine) we will look for the detour to the picnic area of Abi, which is where we will park the car.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the parking lot following the forest track in 10 minutes we will cross the bed of the ravine.

Tour: (machine translated)

Short descent, with long rappels, very interesting in spring, quite slippery in its intermediate zones, reequipped with parabolts and reinforced ring with sheet metal on the 3 rappels.

Return: (machine translated)

The return of this canyon can be losing, we must take into account that we must go up the Estarrún river (assess its flow), about 200 meters then to the left going backwards we will look for the clearest area, to find a small wall that we will have to climb, III^º, from there we will go out to the fields and look for the track to go directly to the parking, 20 minutes if we embark in the area of the wall.


