We cross the Uhaytza river and at the next detour we continue straight ahead and the rest of the crossings on the right. We will reach a bridge over the stream, there is a sign indicating the Oilloki ravine. We continue for about 500m and arrive at Larrandaburu. We continue along the track with the car as far as we can.

The next bridge is Hutsarteko and we will see that the cuts of Kakouetta end, we arrive at the beginning of the valley to the Cayolar de Larregorry where we leave the forest to some meadows. Here we leave the car
