Last two pools always have water, avoidable but not easily.

We must be located in the beautiful village of Camprodon, in the heart of the Pyrenees of Girona.

We will take the C-17 to Ripoll, there we will take the C-26 and then the N-260 towards Sant Joan de les

Abadesses, where a little more than a kilometer past the town we will take the C-38 to Camprodon.

Follow the C-38 until the traffic circle where you will see the detour to Urb Font-Rubí and the golf course. We will pass the golf course and a few meters we have an esplanade on the right and the panel with the Font de Sant

Patllari, we can park here if we see the track in bad condition.

If the track is good we follow it to the fountain where we will park.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the fountain the track ends but follows a small path that crosses our torrent, from here it goes up the orographic left zigzagging up to an altitude of about 1140m where we will access

Tour: (machine translated)

Combination of ledges and rappels of little difficulty, in a very aesthetic environment with a very worked river bed.

The last pools after the access road always have water, they can be circumvented but not easily.

Possibility of doing it with water after rains or with snow in winter.

Return: (machine translated)

We can finish where we cross the trail or follow two more rappels in which case we will exit to the right going uphill to go to the trail and the fountain.

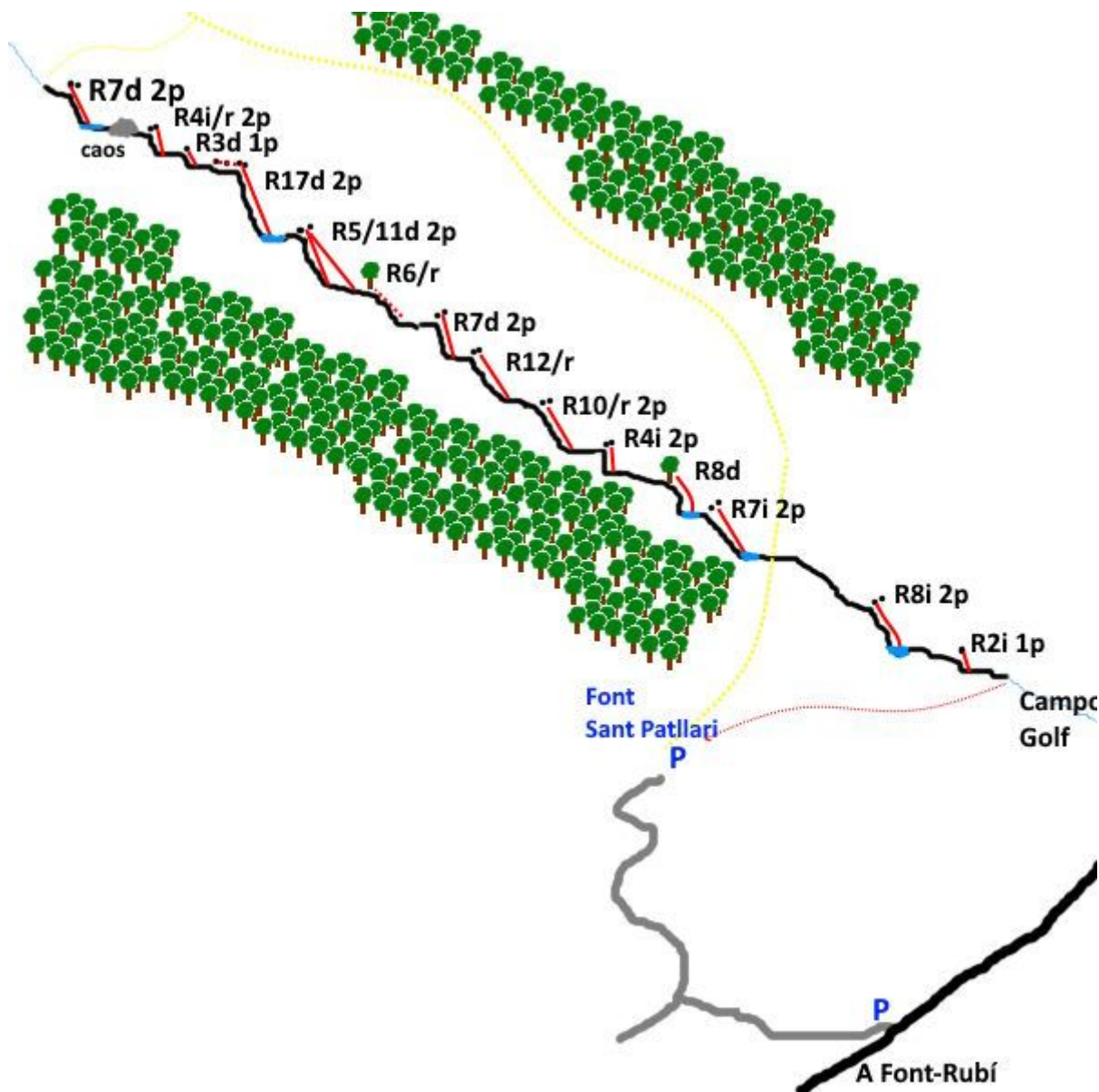
