Alpine canyon in a beautiful setting. It is not very demanding, but most of the abseils are not very easy. So pay attention to the water level, which can change during the walk.

The access trail starts directly above the parking lot. It crosses the Tsanfleuronne at point 1754. If you only want to do the 2nd part, you can enter the canyon here. Continue along the well-marked path until you reach a large hairpin bend on the left directly below the Hotel du Sanetsch. Leave the path to the right, pass a ditch and then a small hump and enter the canyon.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

The first part consists of a series of waterfalls and jumps that lead to a 26-meter-long section that is dangerous for ropes. This part exits after two or three abseils and/or downclimbs.

After a short hike on the right bank, you reach the second part, whose rocks are more beautiful and the surroundings more beautiful. It is characterized by a beautiful waterfall about 60 m long, divided into three easy relays.
