The upper Larri ravine is a spectacular descent. It is located in the Pineta Valley above the Llanos de la Larri (magnificent high mountain scenery). The start is at more than 2,000 meters. Long access. Technical descent with difficult steps. Abundant and very cold water. The route alternates open stretches with some narrow sections. More than 10 waterfalls, maximum 50 meters, to be done in summer-autumn.

From Ainsa we will go towards France (A-138) and when we get to Bielsa (before going through the tunnel), we turn left towards the Parador Nacional de Pineta. Continue along the road until you reach the base of the cirque, about 500m before the Parador. On the left we have a parking lot

Approach: (machine translated)

From the parking and following the GR (red and white marks) we continue along the signs that indicate Llanos de La Larri. Upon reaching the plains we see in front of us the ravine and a path that zig-zags up the slope (the one on the right goes to La Munía). After overcoming the pass, just turn left towards the entrance of the ravine.

Tour: (machine translated)

A long succession of rappels (15) and small, more or less technical, slopes. Beware of overhangs with flow

Return: (machine translated)

After the last rappel you come out to the Llano path. You just have to undo the ascent


