Nice canyon at the head of the Vall de Cabó, with magnificent views and good rappels of up to 60m, although most of them are not very steep. Generally we will find it dry, except after rains.

Possible the gully does not become completely embedded except at specific moments.

Cabó Valley

We will go to the town of Organyà by the C14.

Ravines Vall de Cabó, Senyús, Fondo and Caners.

Once in Organyà, direction Seu d'Urgell, in the center of the village before the right curve we have a detour to the left to Cabó. We get in here.

We follow the road all the way to Cabó, cross the bridge and here it ends, so we continue along the track to the upper part of the valley.

The track goes along the orographic left bank of the river that will take us to Anell (exit of the barranc del Fondo) and shortly after crosses the bank and goes up to Mas d'Encamp. After passing the Mas, after about 500m we will have a track on the left. We park here

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Access Caners and Fondo

We will go up this track that will become a path towards the chalk that will take us up to the Tossal de Caners.

Before that, at about 1600m above sea level there is a path to the right that goes through the forest in a NW direction. When we cross a track on the left we will reach the torrent of Caners.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Not very steep descent, with great views and a quite vertical first part with a 62 and a 53 rappel.

**Return:** (machine translated)

When we reach the confluence with the Cap de la Vall we will see a path in front of us that takes us up to the track that goes on the other side. Follow the track down to the car.
