Summary: (machine translated)

Beautiful aquatic granite gorge; automatic bedload barrier that can open at any time; info and permission for ascents at Alpinsport Koller (Tel: +436505545776); siphon in the middle section (dangerous only at high water level); most rappelling points are in the watercourse; most beautiful sunlight in the afternoon; well equipped; for rope retrieval a 40m rope is recommended.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From the Tauernautobahn A10, take the Gmünd exit. After the traffic circle, follow the Maltatal Landestrasse L12 to the large Fallbach parking lot. At the exit of the parking lot, turn left and cross the small bridge over the Malta. After the Pension Jahn, keep right at the junction. You will soon reach the Gössgraben parking lot. Park here. There is no need for a shuttle car on this tour. (With a shuttle car, follow the road after Pension Jahn straight up to the bridge. Parking on the left after the bridge)

Approach: (machine translated)

Follow the hiking trail on the orographic left side of the canyon. Here you have the opportunity to take a look or two into the canyon. At 980m, you climb left into the stream before the bridge. ! The actual amount of water in the canyon should be assessed at the bridge (entry), as the water is diverted before the bridge and fed back in after the exit!

Tour: (machine translated)

Depending on the water passage, the difficulty of the canyon increases. The first steps are often conquered under the watchful eye of curious hikers. Several abseiling points follow without much distance, some of which can also be jumped or slid. In the canyon, there are always opportunities to avoid abseiling points or to find a safe place when the water rises. However, the canyon should not be underestimated. The last waterfall is the highest. Here you reach a tree on the right via a fixed traversese rope from which you can rappel 12m or jump into large pools. Exit right next to the viewing platform (870m).

Return: (machine translated)

From the viewing platform, follow the hiking trail down to the parking lot.
