#### **Hydrology:**

Access: (machine translated)

From Sütlegen first to the parking exit. Follow the signs for Ermali on the main road in a north-easterly direction. 2400 m after leaving the central square in Sütlegen, turn right downhill from the main road. 500 m further on, turn left at an acute angle and again 480 m slightly downhill at the junction on the right. Now almost another 300m, then we park the car for the exit on the right on the open space in front of the last houses. Take the second car back to the main road and turn right. After 2.9 km we reach the point where the Kibris

Take the second car back to the main road and turn right. After 2.9 km we reach the point where the Kibris crosses under the dam in a pipe culvert on which the road walks. North of the road we see an old mill. We park our second car here.

#### Approach: (machine translated)

On the left bank, a clear path leads down to the stream, where it disappears between the rocks (entry).

### **Tour:** (machine translated)

We take turns walking in and next to the water, climbing down a few steps and "completing" 9 rappels. The highlight is a natural window through which we rappel.

## Return: (machine translated)

If you do not know the exit, it will be difficult to find it with a description. Therefore, it seems expedient to go downstream after the 9th rappel until you see a bridge about 10m above you. From the bridge go back about 30m and upstream, then you will find the exit on the right (orographic. left - east). It is hard to see if there are no fixed ropes hanging down (from commercial operators).
