From Bern, Interlaken or from Lucerne, Sarnen we come to Meiringen in the Aare valley. We now drive in the direction of the Grimsel Pass and after a good 2 km turn right onto the Scheidegg road to Rosenlaui in the Reichenbach valley. After the hamlet of Zwirgi we have to "feed" a toll machine. We continue to the Hotel Rosenlaui and park our car about 300m further on in the parking lot for the tourist walk in the Rosenlaui Gorge (1360m altitude - see approach in photo gallery).

Approach: (machine translated)

We take the hiking trail to Engelhornhütte. At 1487m altitude we cross the Rosenlauischlucht to its orographic. right canyon rim. The trail walks towards a large rock where we then enter the canyon.

Tour: (machine translated)

From a tree we rope from the canyon rim into the streambed, which is still wide here. Then the rappels begin, 12 in all. Deeper and deeper the streambed digs itself in. At the same time, the canyon becomes darker. It ends with a 28m waterfall. In the now again wide streambed downward, to the next streambed confluence from the left, before the right bend of our stream (see photos and videos).

Here left up towards the restaurant and on the hiking trail back down to the car.

A very rarely accessible canyon. There is usually only a short time window in which professionals can attempt a canyoning tour here. The Rosenlaui is a very beautiful and absolutely worthwhile canyon. It is a very short tour. The water is fresh and long waiting times are not recommended. The condition of the anchors is borderline in places. The canyon is narrow and deep, it also gets relatively dark for a short time - I only used my headlamp to take photos. We had a 30m and a 55m rope with us - with the 55 meter rope we got down everywhere on the double line without any problems. Note on the "short time window": It is a canyon that is open to tourists. Canyoning is prohibited during the season. We were in Rosenlaui shortly after the end of the season. A few days later, we wanted to go to Rosenlaui a second time. We abandoned the second attempt on the approach at -8°C, as the road was already completely iced over and it was impossible to make any progress.
