Typical alpine ravine below the ibón de Sen. Long access with vehicle by track but the approach is short and very pleasant. Better in spring or early autumn with good flows to gain in spectacularity. We will finish after the spectacular waterfall of the Engrotá.

**Access:** (machine translated)

We have to go to San Juan de Plan, for this we arrive at Ainsa and take the A138 towards France. After Lafortunada and before reaching Bielsa we will have a detour to the right to Salinas, Valle de Chistau, Gistain, etc.. We will go along this road passing through Plan and soon San Juan de Plan. In the village, the road makes a turn to the left and there is a street on the right that turns into a track, we follow it and cross the Cinqueta. The next bridge is the Sen river (parking place for the Sen river). We will continue along the track towards the hermitage of San Mamés and continue. From the village we will have more than 9km to cross the Sen river again, now in its upper part. Here we will see a sign indicating the path up to the Ibón de Sen. We park.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Along the path that goes up to Ibón de Sen for about 20-30min until the bridge that crosses the riverbed.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Alpine descent, open, slippery and with a spring atmosphere with good flows. After the junction with the Pardina ravine, our ravine gains more water and we find the 30m waterfall. After this rapell we will have two other short ones of about 10m to finish the descent.

**Return:** (machine translated)

After the last rapell we come out onto the meadows and we can continue on to the track or turn right onto the uphill trail.
